

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY ON A DECISION

of the Standing Committee on Humanities and Arts on the results of the completed evaluation under a procedure for programme accreditation of a professional field 8.4 Theatre and Film Art, an area of higher education 8. Arts at the South-West University “Neofit Rilski”

The procedure was opened by the Standing Committee on Humanities and Arts on 04.10.2018 at the request of the higher school. The Expert Panel, approved by the Accreditation Council on 07.03.2019, carried out an inspection of the evaluated institution in the period from 09.05.2019 to 11.05.2019.

At a meeting held on 19.06.2019, the Standing Committee adopted the Expert panel's report and, based on it, prepared a decision on the results of the completed programme accreditation. The decision **stipulates findings and assessments regarding the compliance of the evidence submitted with the criteria system in the implemented procedure, and in accordance with the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG) - Part 1 / 1-10 / and within the meaning of Art. 78, para. 3 of the HEA (Table 4). The Standing Committee used the 10-point assessment system provided for in Art. 79, para. 1 of the HEA and the rating scale of ENQA.**

After summarising the results of the voting on the basis of the "Rules for voting on procedures for accreditation and project evaluation" adopted by the Accreditation Council of NEAA, the Standing Committee on Humanities and Arts took the following **DECISION on 17.07.2019:**

1. Awards programme accreditation to a professional field 8.4 Theatre and Film Art, an area of higher education 8. Arts at the South-West University “Neofit Rilski” on the grounds of an overall assessment of 9.00 (nine), as follows:

For EQD “Bachelor”

- 1. Film and Television Directing - full-time training**
- 2. Film and Television Operating - full-time training**
- 3. Film and Television Editing - full-time training**
- 4. Acting- full-time training**

For EQD “Master”

- 1. Film and Television Directing - full-time training**
- 2. Film and Television Operating - full-time training**

3. **Film and Television Editing** - full-time training
4. **Theatre Directing**- full-time training
5. **Actor for Cinema and Television** - full-time training

2. The period of validity of the accreditation shall be SIX years, in accordance with Art. 79, para. 4 of the HEA.

3. Determines a capacity for the professional field 8.4 Theatre and Film Art, an area of higher education 8. Arts at the South-West University “Neofit Rilski”, as follows:

- for EQD “Bachelor” - 190 students – full-time training.
- for EQD “Master” - 20 students – full-time training.

Total for the professional field – 210 students.

The Standing Committee on humanities and art has formulated the following recommendations:

1. To enhance the academic growth of the teaching staff in the professional field.

Deadline: 2020-2021

2. To create conditions for teamwork in the preparation of graduation production of graduates.

Deadline: Permanent.

3. To update the library stock with new editions, especially with regard to theatre

Deadline: Permanent.

The overall verbal assessment in compliance with the resulting numeric one is full compliance.
