

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ON A DECISION OF THE ACCREDITATION COUNCIL

on the results from the completed procedure for post-accreditation monitoring and control on the implementation of the recommendations stipulated in the decision of the Standing Committee on Humanities and Arts of 08.10.2014 at program accreditation of a professional field 2.1 "Philology" at Shumen University "Ep. Konstantin Preslavski "

The procedure was opened at a meeting of the Standing Committee on post-accreditation monitoring and control of 13.09.2018 in accordance with the Schedule for post-accreditation monitoring and control and procedures adopted by the Accreditation Council pursuant to art. 70 and art. 63 of the Rules of Procedure of NEAA. At a meeting held on 10.01.2019, the Standing Committee on PAMC adopted a report on the implementation of the recommendations and prepared a draft decision of the Accreditation Council based on the analysis of the required report from the higher school and the evidence provided. The draft decision reflected **observations and assessments on the implementation of the recommendations.**

After considering the report of the Standing Committee on post-accreditation monitoring and control the Accreditation Council took the following **DECISIONS** on 24.01.2019:

1. Approves the report of the SC on PAMC on the post-accreditation monitoring and control over the implementation of the recommendations stipulated in the decision of the Standing Committee on Humanities and Arts of 08.10.2014 (Protocol № 16) at programme accreditation of a professional field 2.1 "Philology" for an educational and qualification degrees "Bachelor" and "Master" at Shumen University "Ep. Konstantin Preslavski " with an overall assessment 9.01 (nine, point one hundredths).

2. The Accreditation Council notes that Shumen University "Ep. Konstantin Preslavski "has fulfilled recommendations № 2 and № 3 and is fulfilling recommendation № 1, formulated in the decision of the Standing Committee on Humanities and Arts of 03.07.2014 (Protocol № 16) at programme accreditation of a professional field 2.1 "Philology" for an educational and qualification degrees "Bachelor" and "Master" an overall assessment 9.01 (nine, point one hundredths).

3. After providing access to the MES registry of active and discontinued students and PhD students, the SC on PAMC will submit a report to the Accreditation Council on the compliance with the capacity of the professional field 2.1

"Philology" at Shumen University "Ep. Konstantin Preslavski ".
