

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ON A DECISION OF THE ACCREDITATION COUNCIL

**for the outcome of the completed post-accreditation monitoring and control procedure
on the implementation of the recommendations formulated in the decision of the Accreditation Council of 07.12.2017 at program accreditation of a speciality from the regulated professions "Assistant Pharmacist" in the Medical College of the Medical University – Plovdiv**

The procedure was opened at a meeting of the Standing Committee for post-accreditation monitoring and control on 12.11.2020, according to the Schedule for post-accreditation monitoring and control and the Rules of procedures, adopted by the Accreditation Council on the grounds of Art. 70 and Art. 63 of the Rules of Procedure of NEAA. At a meeting held on 18.03.2021, the Standing Committee on PAMC, based on the analysis of the required report from the higher school and the accompanying evidence, adopted a report on implementing the recommendations and drew up a draft decision of the Accreditation Council. The draft decision reflects **findings and assessments on the implementation of the recommendations.**

After considering the report of the Standing Committee for post-accreditation monitoring and control, the Accreditation Council took the following **DECISIONS** on **08.04.2021:**

1. Approves the report of the SC on PAMC on the post-accreditation monitoring and control on the implementation of the recommendations, formulated in the decision of the Accreditation Council of 07.12.2017 (Minute of meeting No 27) at program accreditation of a speciality from the regulated professions "Assistant Pharmacist " for an education and qualification degree "Professional Bachelor" in the Medical College of the Medical University – Plovdiv with a total grade of 8.19 (eight whole and nineteen hundredths).

2. The Accreditation Council finds out that the Medical University – Plovdiv, the Medical College have implemented recommendations № 1, № 2 and № 3, formulated in the decision of the Accreditation Council of 07.12.2017 (Minute of meeting No 27) at program accreditation of a speciality from the regulated professions "Assistant Pharmacist" for the educational and qualification degree "Professional Bachelor" with a total grade of 8.19 (eight whole and nineteen

hundredths).
